



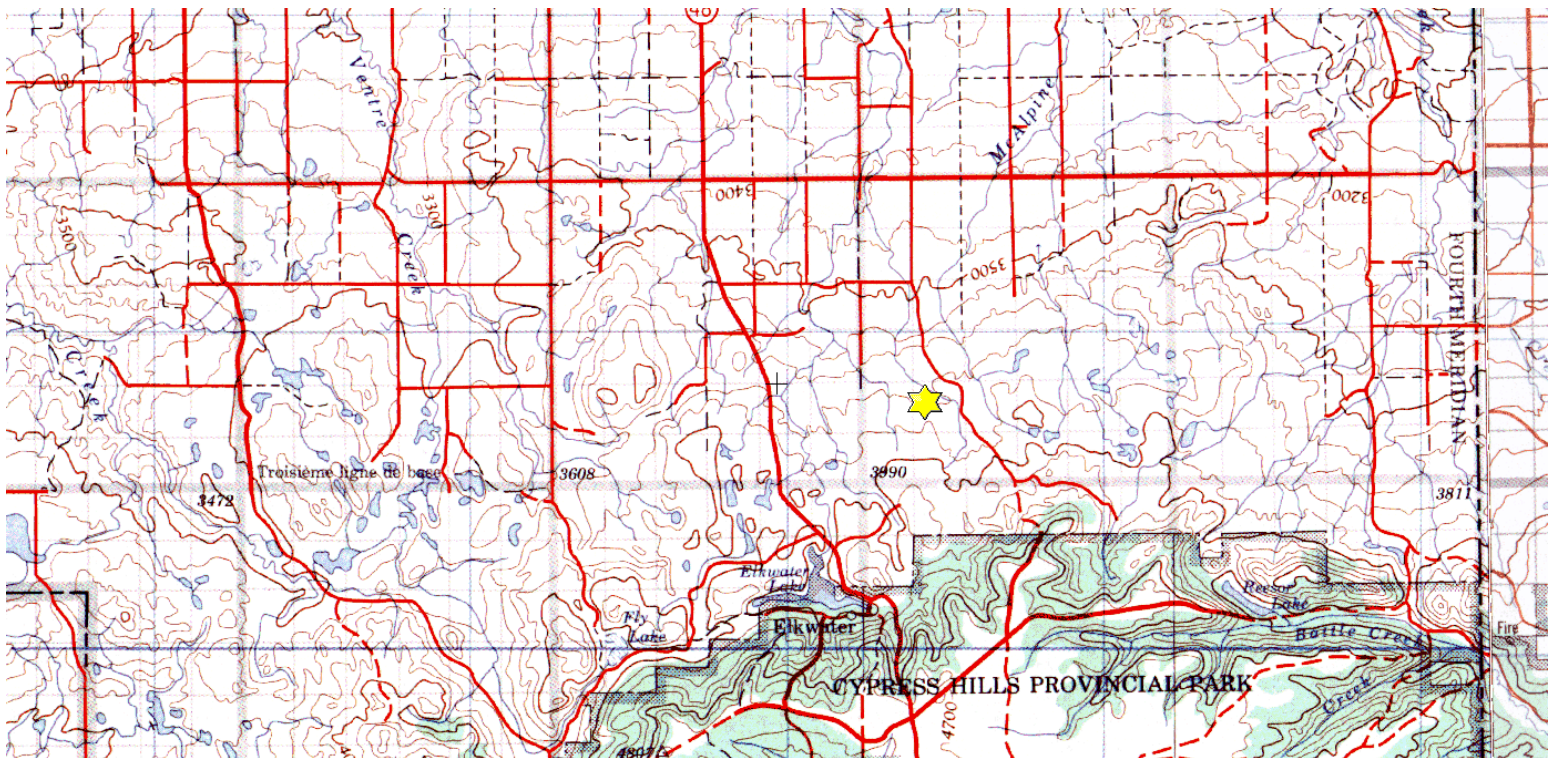
Bull Trail

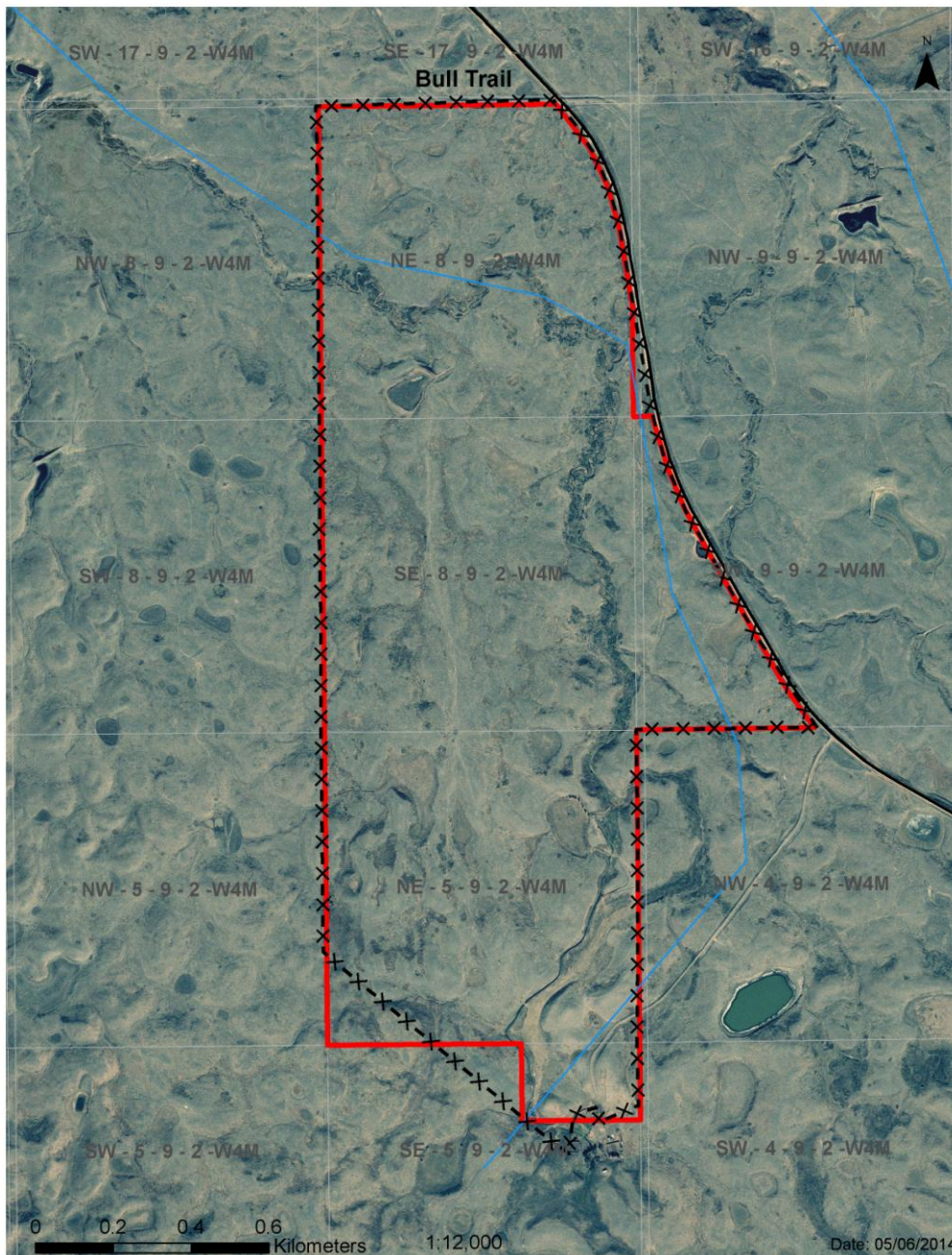

Description: Located near the Cypress Hills, Bull Trail is a 530 acre site that offers rolling grasslands and wetlands that are home to deer, elk, sharp-tailed grouse, and a variety of waterfowl. Several at risk species are found here including the Threatened Sprague's pipit. Many partners came together to invest in this parcel of important native grassland.
