


Hebert Lake Uplands


Parts of NW/SE-19-037-18-W4M, Part of SW-20-037-18-W4M

Description: This 259 acre site is located approximately 22 km southeast of Stettler and links Hebert Lake and Beltz Lake Conservation Sites. It provides excellent habitat for waterfowl and shorebirds and excellent breeding habitat for a variety of grassland songbirds such as western meadowlarks, Sprague's pipits, Baird's sparrows and occasionally loggerhead shrikes. The site also provides habitat for white-tailed and mule deer and the occasional moose. A 10 acre subdivision in the northwest corner of NW 19 is not part of this site.
