


Jackpine Property NW-22-59-15-W4M

Description: The Jack Pine Property is located just west of the town of Bellis, 19 kilometres east of Smokey Lake on highway 28. The property consists of about 161 acres and lies on the north side of the highway. Mature Jack Pine trees dominate the landscape and trembling aspen, balsam poplar, birch, alder, willow and rose can also be found on the property. The property has very sandy soil and therefore produces a sparse under story. Wildlife found on the property includes white-tailed deer, moose, fox, coyote, and a variety of small game and bird species. A low intensity ground fire swept through the west half of the property in the spring of 2002. Little long-term damage resulted from the fire and should in fact result in a regeneration of young jack pines with the releasing of seeds from fire susceptible pinecones.
