



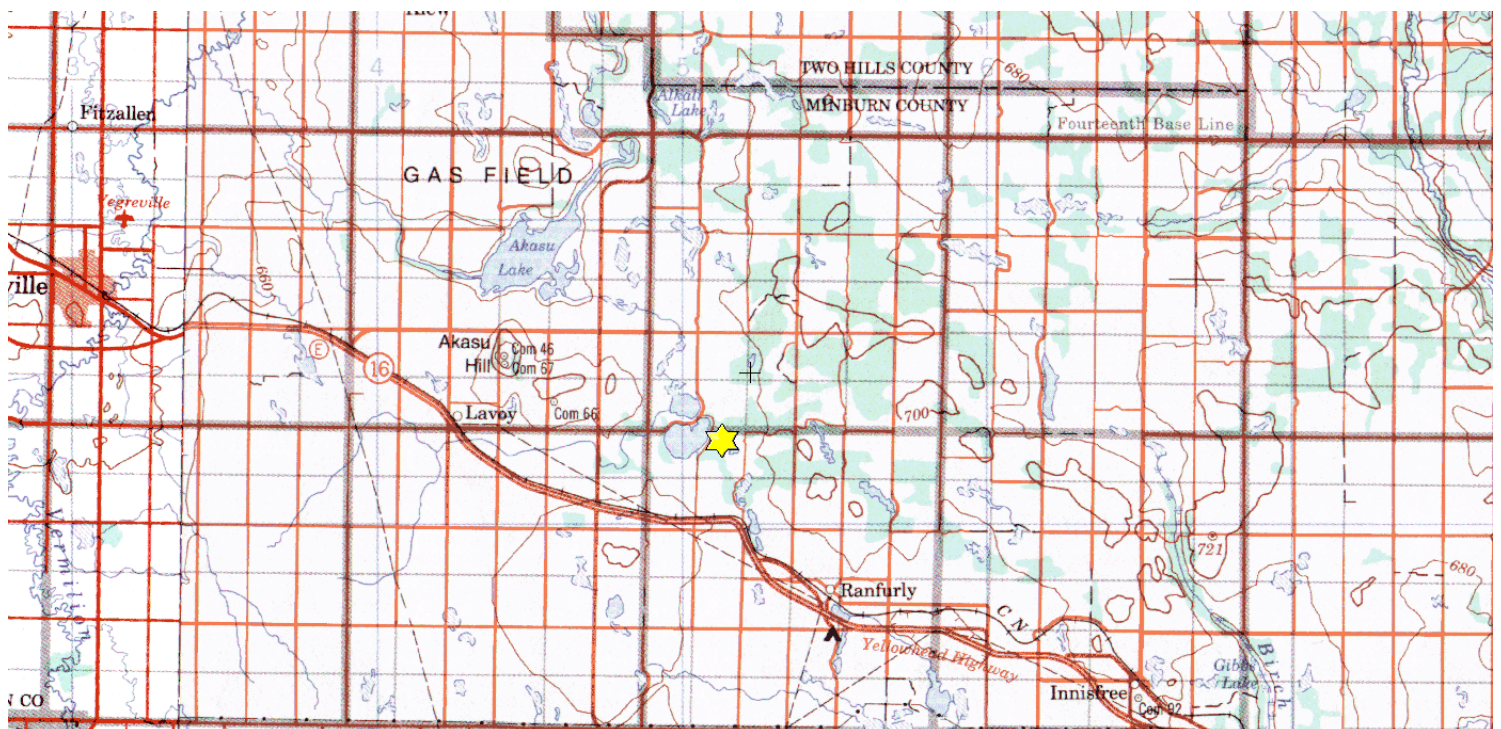
Junction Lake

Pt. NW 32-51-12-W4

Description: Located approximately 110 km east of the City of Edmonton, it has rolling hills, abundant wetlands, healthy forests and large saline lakes. Junction Lake provides critical habitat for the endangered piping plover as well as a wide variety of other shore birds and waterfowl. Plans for further improvements at the site include laying gravel along a key shoreline to make it more attractive to breeding plovers, fencing portions of the property to manage access, and installing a viewing platform to provide nature enthusiasts the opportunity to watch plovers from a safe distance. White-tailed deer and moose are also regular residents on the property.

Special Restrictions: Day use only. No open fires. No target shooting. Foot access only.
