



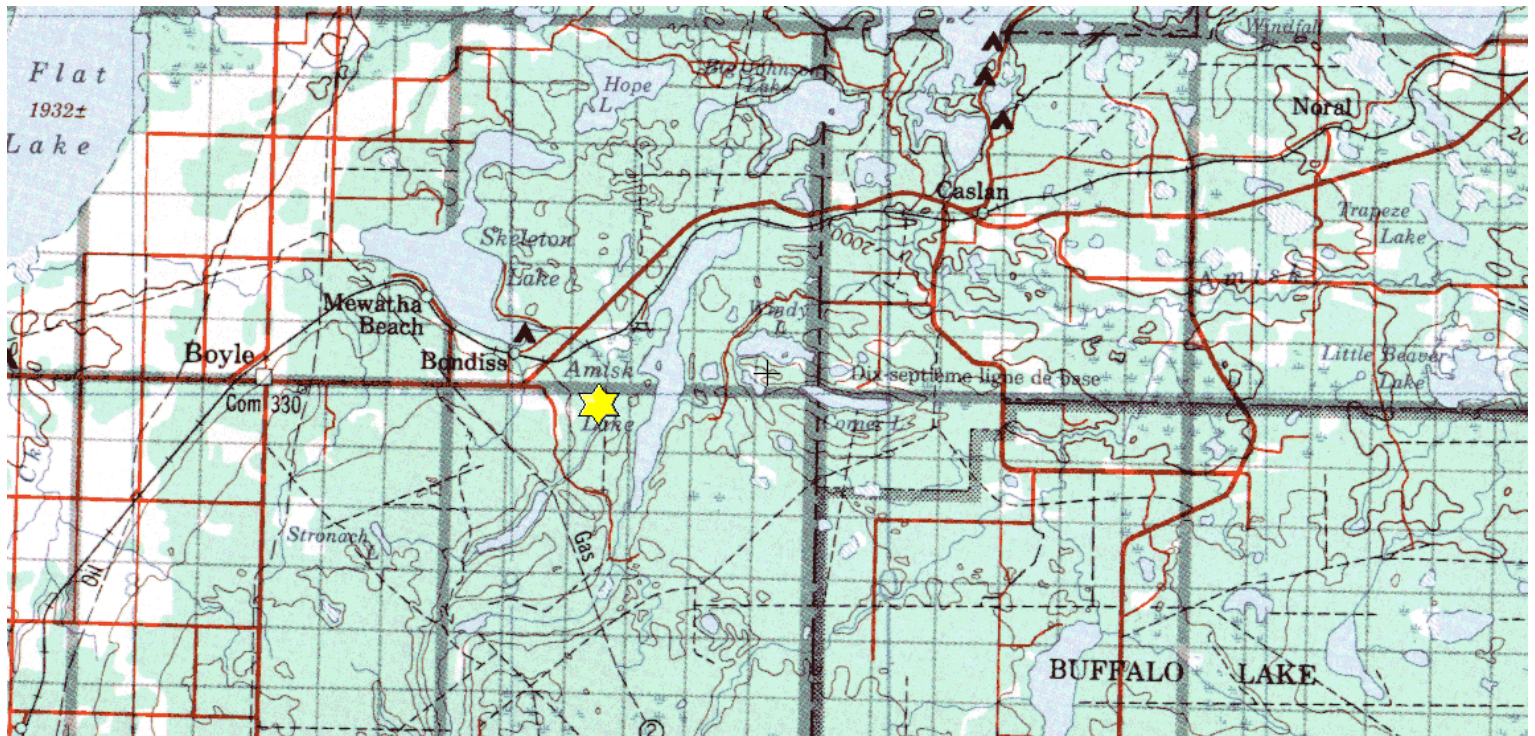
Karvonen Property

NW-33-064-18-W4M, SE-33-064-18-W4M

Description: Conserved in a natural state by the Karvonen family for over 15 years, this 160 acre site, located approximately 8 km east of Boyle, has been maintained as native boreal habitat in an area of the province where boreal forest is being lost at a rapid pace. A small 20 acre lake occurs on the site, and beavers, muskrats and otters have been spotted there. Pileated woodpeckers, “cinnamon bears” and several small fur bearers also call this location home. Several trails exist and have been heavily utilized over the years for cross country skiing, hiking and wildlife viewing.
