


Kneehill Property SE 35-34-27-W4M 160 Acres

Description: The Kneehill Creek Property is located approximately 20 kilometres southeast of Innisfail. The property is 160 acres in size and Kneehill Creek runs north to south through the entire length of the property, accounting for over half a mile of creek channel. A couple beaver dams, resulting in some large pools of water, can be found at the southeast corner of the property. Trembling aspen and balsam poplar dominate the forested portion of the property. Moose, mule deer and white-tailed deer regularly utilize the property and ducks and other waterfowl are found on the beaver ponds and creek during the spring, summer and fall months. A multitude of other wildlife species can be seen on the property and include coyote, fox, blue heron, beaver, hawks, songbirds, ruffed grouse and many other parkland species.
