



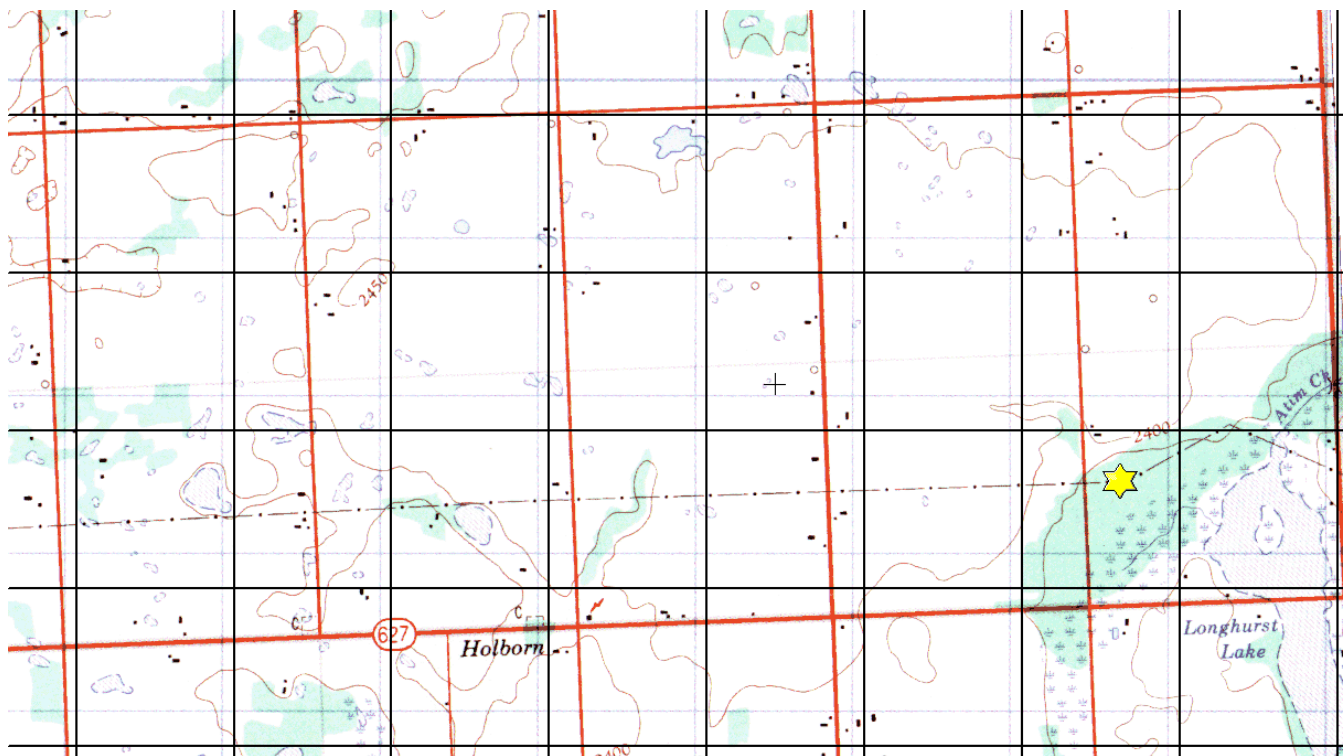
# Letourneau

**SW-1-052-01-W5M**

**Description:** This 79-acre site is nestled in the central parkland only 10 km south of downtown Stony Plain and 22 km west of Edmonton. The Letourneau Conservation Site consists of lush riparian habitat, native mixedwood and old growth coniferous forest that boast a highly productive understory full of Labrador tea, lichens and moss. Longhurst Lake borders the southeast corner of the Conservation Site and provides excellent birdwatching opportunities. Atim Creek, a tributary to the Sturgeon River, flows through the southeast portion of the site into Longhurst Lake. Wildlife found in the area includes songbirds, white-tailed deer, moose, ruffed grouse, fur-bearers and waterfowl
