


North Fawcett NE-31-64-1-W5

Description: This 150-acre property lies 1.6 kilometres from the banks of the meandering Pembina River; a river originating in the Canadian Rockies foothills and merging into the Athabasca River. The opposite bank of the river marks the eastern boundary of Hubert Lake Wildland Provincial Park, which consists of a sand dune complex. Numerous small lakes and wetlands depressions support black spruce and larch, with open fens existing in wetter areas within the park. There are moose, mule deer, white-tailed deer, ruffed grouse and a long list of songbirds.
