



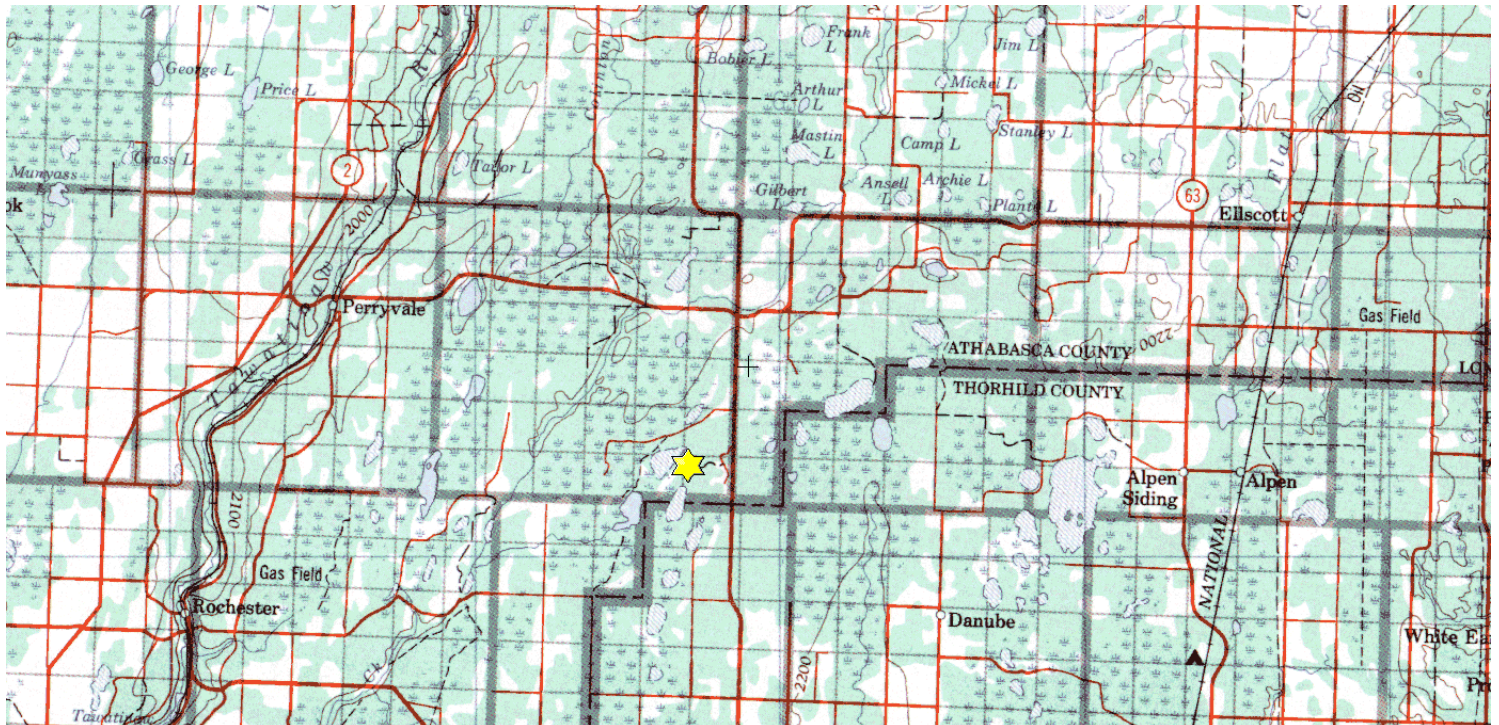
North Pine Creek

NW-01-063-22-W4, Pt. NE-02-063-22-W4M

Description: This 260 acre site lies approximately 33 km south of Athabasca. The South Pine Creek Conservation Site (D3-174) is located 4 km directly south. Access to this site is limited to a surface lease road on the Crown parcel directly north of the site. From Athabasca, travel south on Highway 827 for approximately 33 km, turn west on Twp Rd 632 and travel 1.5 km to reach the surface lease road. Turn south for 0.5 km and follow the trail to its end. Another 200 m along the existing foot trail provides access to the north boundary of the NW 01 parcel. The site consists predominately of mixedwood forest with tamarack, white and black spruce, trembling aspen and paper birch. A large wetland borders the NE 02 parcel along the west boundary. Wildlife found in the area includes mule deer, white-tailed deer, moose, small furbearers and waterfowl.
