

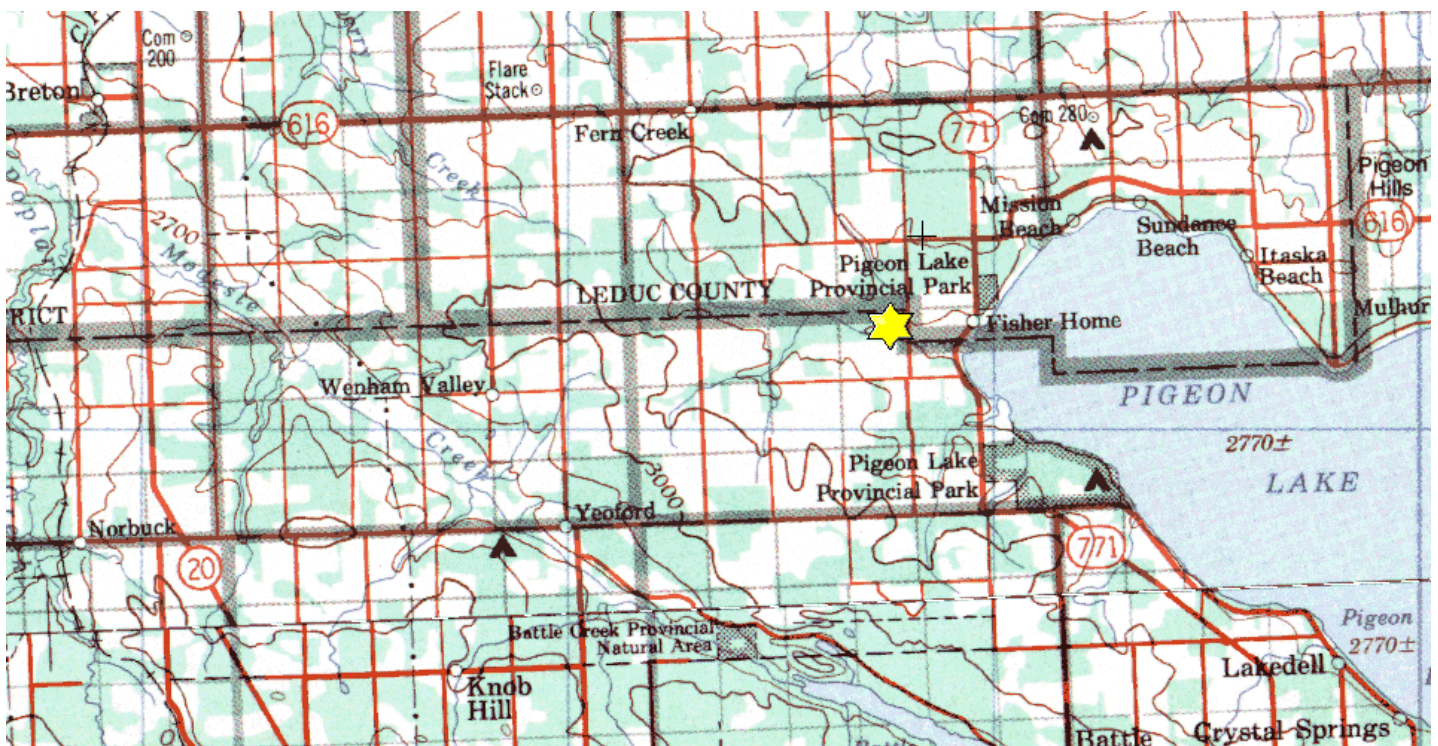


Pigeon Lake Property NE-15-47-2-W5M

Description: This property is located at the northwest corner of Pigeon Lake in the Parkland region of central Alberta. The vegetation consists of mature native shrubs and grasses and Tide Creek runs through both properties. Species frequenting the area include whitetail deer, mule deer, moose, black bear, coyote, beaver, ruffed grouse, snowshoe hare, woodpeckers, many other furbearers and a large variety of bird species. Tide Creek is an important spawning tributary for Pigeon Lake for walleye, pike and suckers.
