



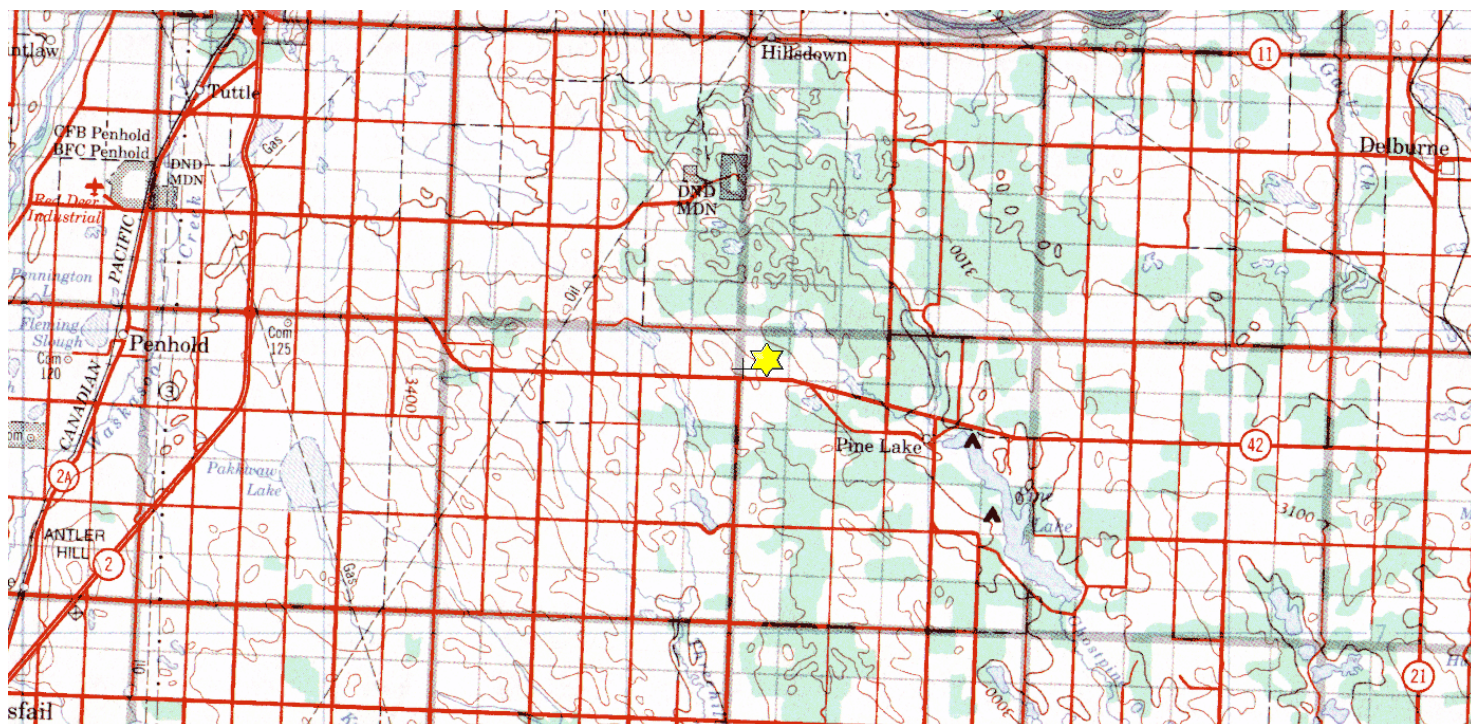

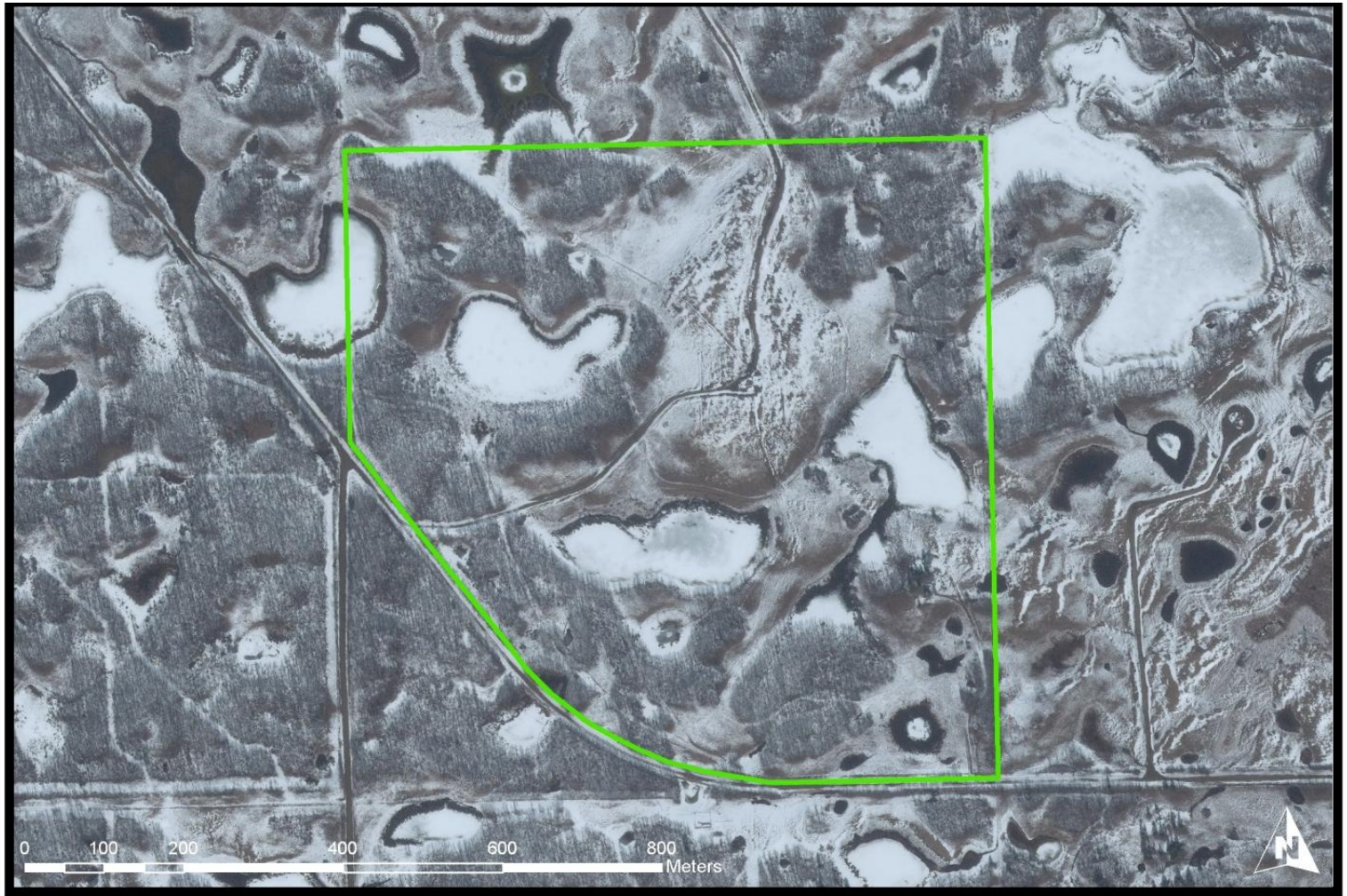

Description: Located in Red Deer County, the Underwood Property is a 140- acre site comprised of a mix of open native and reverting domestic grassland punctuated by native bush that is predominantly trembling aspen with willow in lower lying pockets. Other non-grass species noted include Western Snowberry, Chokecherry, Buffalo Berry, Saskatoon and raspberry bushes, and Wild Rose. A variety of wildlife including waterfowl, raptors, small mammals and white-tailed deer, mule deer and moose are regular residents on the property. Numerous wetlands are found on the property as well and provide staging and nesting sites for waterfowl.
