Description: TransAlta has been a significant part of the Wabamun landscape since 1956 and has provided employment opportunities and electricity for a growing Alberta. With the decommissioning of the plant, TransAlta is donating several parcels of land to be maintained as habitat through the WTF. The 54.5 acre Wabamun North Shoreline Property ensures that the environmental and habitat values along the lake are maintained into the future. There is prime fish spawning habitat, shore birds, a wide diversity of waterfowl associated with the riparian habitats. The uplands are diverse and provide year-round cover for deer and moose. Songbirds, wood peckers and a host of other wildlife utilize the diverse uplands and tree cover associated with this site. The productive nesting habitats on the property are what draw such a wide diversity of wildlife.
