



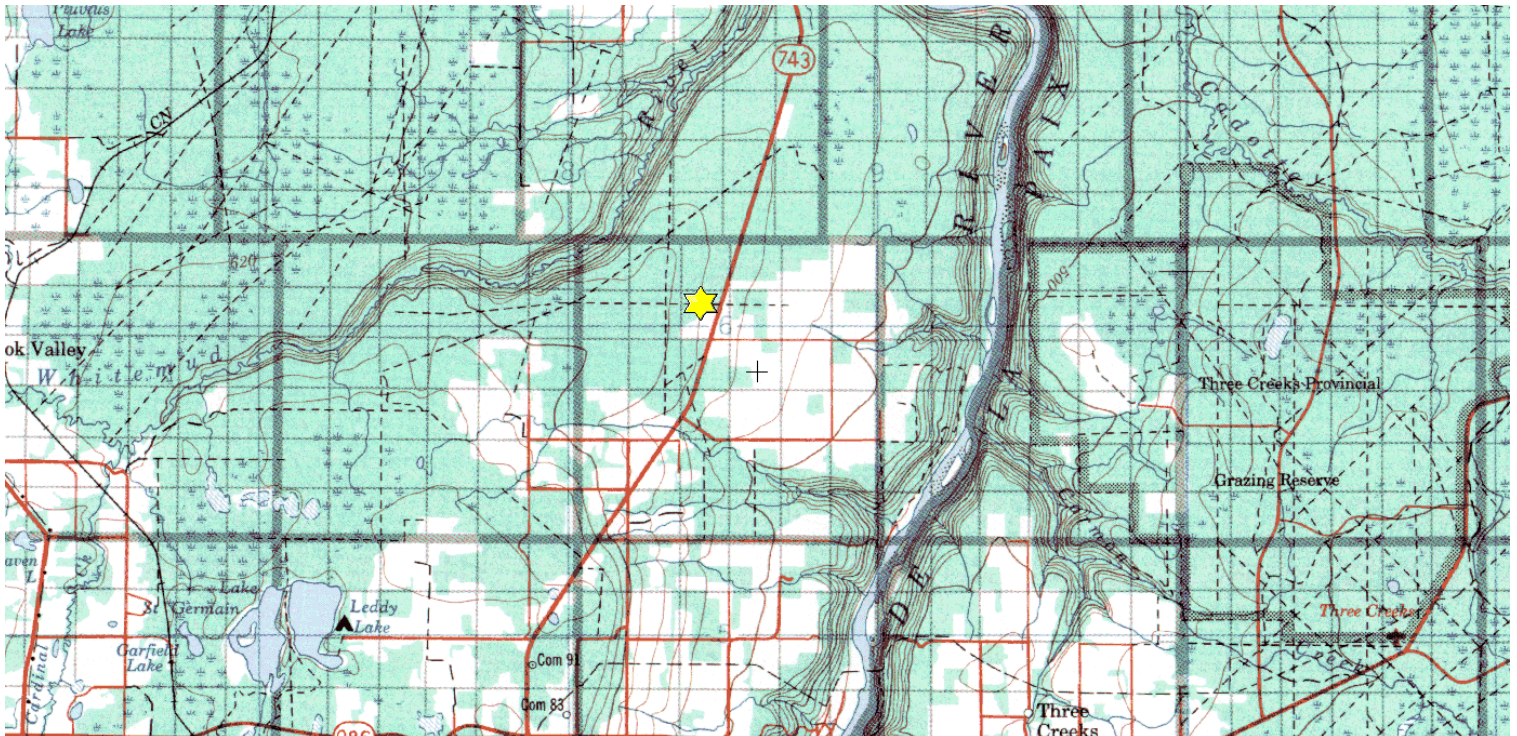
# Whispering Timber

**NW/NE/SW/SE-33-086-21-W5M**

**Description:** This 608-acre site is located 36 km north of the town of Peace River via Secondary Highway 743 and Township Road 870. It consists entirely of boreal mixed-wood vegetation that has naturally regenerated from historical logging that occurred here. The young age class of forest provides excellent habitat for moose, white-tailed deer, elk, black bear, small furbearers and ruffed grouse.
