


Whispering Timber

NW/NE/SW/SE-33-086-21-W5M

Description: This 608-acre site is located 36 km north of the town of Peace River via Secondary Highway 743 and Township Road 870. It consists entirely of boreal mixedwood vegetation that has naturally regenerated from historical logging that occurred here. The young age class of forest provides excellent habitat for moose, white-tailed deer, elk, black bear, small furbearers and ruffed grouse.
