

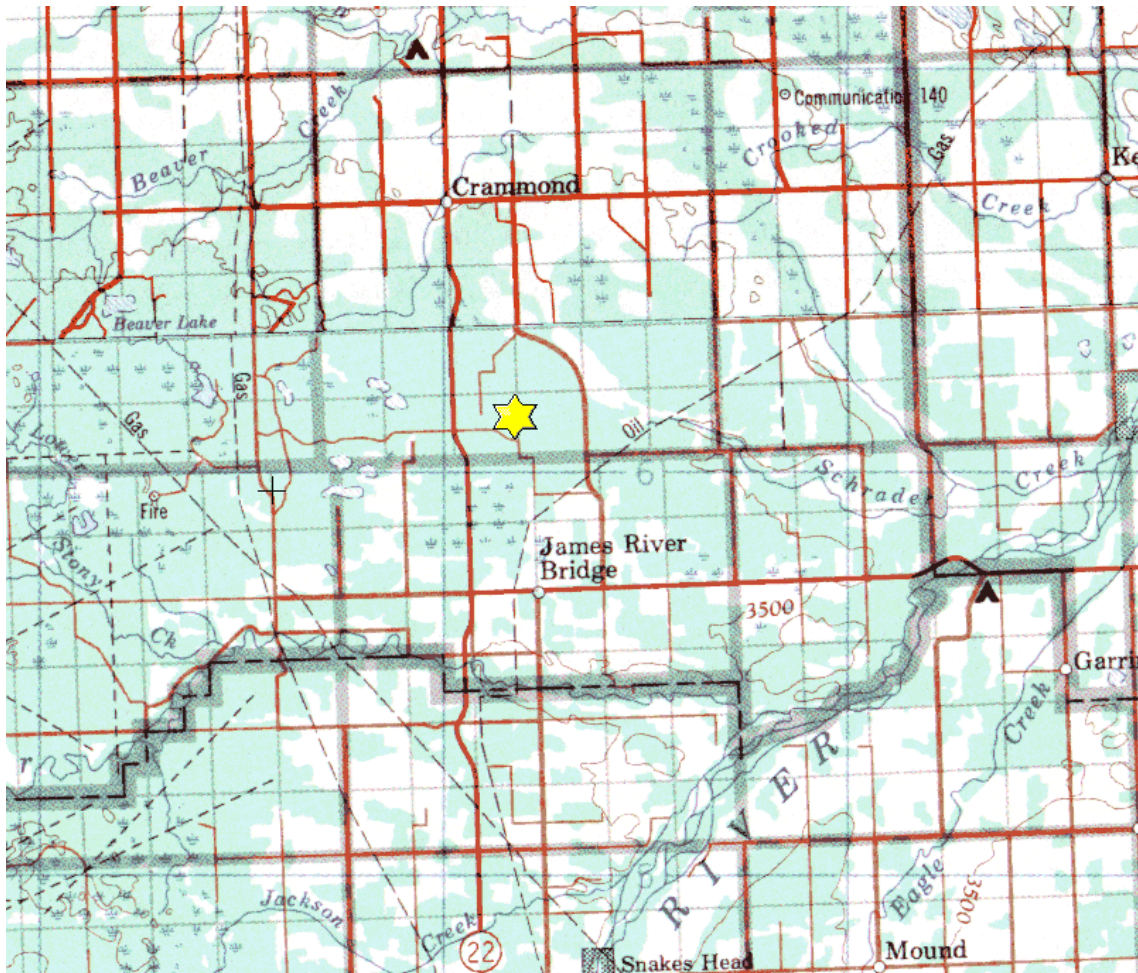


Caroline/Shell Canada Property SW-3-35-5-W5M

Description: This quarter section is situated in the dry mixedwood subregion of the Boreal Forest Natural Area of Alberta southeast of the town of Caroline. The forest consists of mature pine, trembling aspen, balsam poplar, birch, alder, willow, Saskatoon, chokecherry and rose can also be found on the property. White and black spruces are also prevalent throughout. Wildlife found on the property includes white-tailed and mule deer, moose, elk, black bear, fox, coyote, and occasionally wolf and even grizzly bear. A variety of small mammals and songbirds are residents or regular migrants.
