



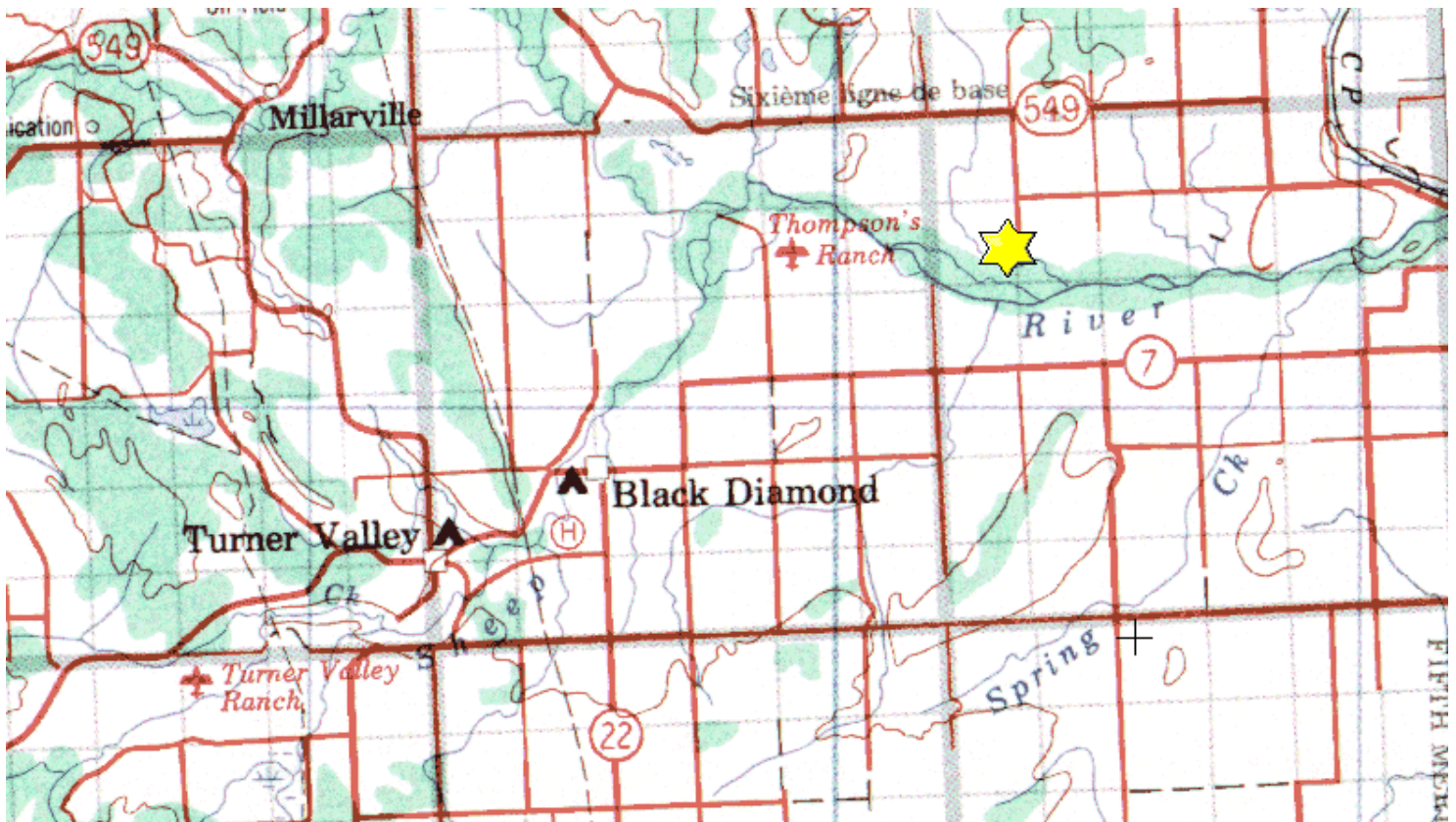
Sheep River Properties

Portions of NE-19-20-01-W5M, NW-20-20-01-W5M

Description: The Sheep River Property is located west of Okotoks in the Foothills region of southwestern Alberta and encompasses 54 acres. The vegetation consists of mature cottonwoods, native shrubs and grasses. The property lies within the flood plain of the Sheep River. There is a dry oxbow channel in the middle of the property that holds water in the spring. A natural spring exists at the east end of the property. Species frequenting the area include whitetail deer, mule deer, elk, moose, cougar, wolf, black bear, coyote, pheasant, turkey, ruffed grouse, snowshoe hare, raccoons, woodpeckers, many other furbearers and a large variety of bird species. Mountain whitefish and rainbow trout are the two dominant fish species found on this stretch of the river.
