Description: This 160-acre property is representative of the Pigeon Lake Focal Area and consists of Tamarack bogs, Aspen and Balsam Poplar stands and Birch stands typical of the Boreal Mixedwood Subregion. The 20-acre wetland, located along the northwest portion of the property, provides habitat for waterfowl staging and production as well as numerous amphibian species. The gently rolling topography contributes suitable habitat for ungulates and the forest and wetland vegetation communities provide nesting and feeding sites for a diversity of breeding birds, including boreal songbirds. The diversified landscape favours an abundance of wildlife such as mule deer, black bear, moose and red-tailed hawk.
