I welcome you to Narrow Lake Youth Camp, or if you are returning, welcome back! It is my privilege to lead the Narrow Lake Youth Camp for another year. We strive for excellence in all aspects of summer camping for our campers. We are proud of our more than 30 years of excellent providing this summer camp in Alberta. We stand on the side of young people and strive to serve them well. Please take a moment to read through this information: The youth camps are held at Narrow Lake Conservation Centre, which is located approximately 25 minutes southwest of Athabasca.

Due to the success and popularity of our youth camp we will once again be offering two camps this summer. Both camps will offer the same courses and certifications. Please register for the one that fits with your schedule. The camp is open to both girls and boys ages 12-17 (due to Federal firearms regulations all participants must be 12 years of age by the end of the camp week). We take approximately 45 first year students and 15 second year students each week.

Registration is first come first serve until we are full. To secure your child's spot at camp you will need to fill out the 2024 registration forms. You can either email in the completed forms or mail them to me, you will also need to pay the registration fees either by electronic money transfer or a cheque. I need the completed registration forms & fees to add them to the roster. You will receive an email back from me that I have received your registration forms & Payment. After that email no news is good news. The official acceptance letters will be mailed out early May. This will include which week and which level the camper is enrolled in, as well as drop off & pick-up times, recommended packing list and directions. No news is good news, just look for the email in early May with more information.

Our chef is a culinary instructor at N.A.I.T. Our chef is able to accommodate any food allergies as long as it is made aware of on the registration form. There is plenty of food available for all, when seconds are called don't be shy, to go get more till you are full!

This is an Outdoor camp, majority of their time is spent outdoors, including experiencing sleeping in a tent. These are outfitter tents, for the last night of camp the campers get to experience the outdoors and get to sleep in a lean-to that they build. It makes for a fun and eventful experience.

The cost for the week is \$550 per participant, this fee includes all lodging, meals Sunday dinner till Saturday BBQ. Also includes all instruction, course books, course fees and testing for the various certifications. All participants are to take these courses seriously as it is not a guarantee that they will pass their tests.

Please note priority will be given to those campers whose parents or guardians volunteer as a kitchen helper. In order to keep our camp cost reasonable, we rely on our hard working volunteers. It is important to have parents or guardians volunteering as a kitchen helper, without this assistance, it would be tremendously difficult to supply the quality and attention the campers currently receive.
